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of the time of the AGREEMENT,

This is an Agreement entered into by and between WILLIAM ROBERT OPELLE, hereinafter referred to as "trustee," ADELINE PRITCHARD KNEUBUHL, hereinafter referred to as "trustor," and the six children of Adeline Pritchard Kneubuhl, hereinafter referred to as "beneficiaries," who are: FRANCES K. OPELLE, BENJAMIN F. KNEUBUHL, JR., DOUGLASS CRANE KNEUBUHL, MARGARET K. LANDRIGAN, JOHN ALEXANDER KNEUBUHL and ALFRED JAMES PRITCHARD KNEUBUHL.

On or about the 15th day of August, 1960, the trustor transferred to the trustee by a written instrument, certain real property located on the Island of Tutuila, American Samoa, in trust, for the benefit of the beneficiaries above named. Said Trust was recorded in the Register of Transfers of the Territory of American Samoa, Volume 3, pages 76 to 77 under date of August 24, 1960.

By the provisions of said Trust Agreement, the trustee is empowered to manage the parcels of real property transferred to him in whatever manner he deems best. Said trustee is restricted from disposing of any of the trust property without the consent and approval of a majority of the beneficiaries of the Trust.

It is desired by the beneficiaries of the Trust above named, to partition certain of the real property held by the trustee as a part of said Trust, in the manner hereinafter described.

In consideration of the mutual covenants of each $_{\mathrm{Lie}}$

of the parties hereto, it is agreed:

- (1) Each party releases and forever quitclaims to the respective party to whom the real property is allocated hereinafter, all of his right, title and interest in and to said property which he may now or in the future have by virtue of the laws of American Samoa governing the ownership and alienation of land or by any deed to said property.
- (2) Each party covenants to protect the title of the person to whom the property is hereinafter allocated.
- (3) Each of the parties covenants to protect the full and exclusive use and quiet enjoyment of the party by the person to whom it is allocated.
- (4) This Agreement shall in no way modify or alter any covenant of a Grantee to give a right of first refusal to the descendants of Adeline Pritchard Kneubuhl, aka Lena Kneubuhl, contained in any deed respecting any of the real property which constitutes the corpus of the Trust.
- (5) Each of the beneficiaries, for himself and for his issue, hereby approves and consents to the partition and disposal herein made of the real property hereinafter described.
- (6) If for any reason any part of this Agreement is invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

William Robert Opelle, as trustee, Adeline Pritchard Kneubuhl, as trustor and each of the beneficiaries, hereby convey all of their respective right, title and interest in and to the following described real property to the respective

beneficiaries as named:

A. That certain lot and parcel of land, lying in Square 32, Unit "B" and "C", situated in the Village of Taputimu, County of Tualatai, Western District, Island of Tutuila, American Samoa, being portions of Olo, Tagaua'a, Puapua, Lesea and Aso To'elau, in portions as follows:

1. To Frances K. Opelle, all of that portion of said parcel known as Plot "A", (including that portion known as Plot "AA") more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a spike set in a center line of driveway to said property 148 degrees 53 minutes 59 seconds, 32.49 feet from E-3 Road Traverse, run thence South 81 degrees 15 minutes East, 78 feet to a point; thence South 5 degrees 45 minutes West, 100 feet to a point, thence North 81 degrees West, 80 feet to a point; thence North 7 degrees 58 minutes 14 seconds East; 98 feet to the point of beginning, containing at area of 0.20 acres more or less.

In the event that under the laws of American Samoa governing trusts or real property having a situs in American Samoa, the real property herein described cannot legally be partitioned in the manner herein described or conveyed out of the trust by the trustee to the beneficiaries, then the parties hereto agree that legal title to said real property shall remain in the trustee, but each individual beneficiary and his heirs, devisees and assigns shall nevertheless have exclusive right to the use of the portion of said real property which is allocated hereunder to such beneficiary and each of the parties hereto covenants to protect the full and exclusive use and

quiet enjoyment of the property by the beneficiary to whom it is allocated, and by his heirs, devisees and assigns.


